

MR. GAËL BODÉNÈS



Gaël Bodénès graduated in 1991 from ENSTA Bretagne (French naval engineering and research institute) as a naval engineer and also holds an Executive MBA degree of HEC Paris (*Hautes Etudes Commerciales*), 2007.

He began his career for the French Navy (DGA) as a naval engineer in the Newbuilding design department, then joined the sales department of the DCN in Brest (France). In 1998, he joined International Shipbrokers Barry Rogliano Salles as senior offshore shipbroker.

In September 2002, Gaël Bodénès joined BOURBON to supervise the business management of the international fleet. In September 2005, he was appointed Deputy CEO of Bourbon Offshore, and then Chief Operating Officer of the group in January 2011.

He became Chief Executive Officer in September 2017, with the responsibility of the company management under the executive Chairmanship of Jacques de Chateauvieux.

On January 10, 2020, as Société Phocéenne de Participation acquires 100% of the assets of BOURBON Corporation, Gaël Bodénès is confirmed as the group's leader.
