

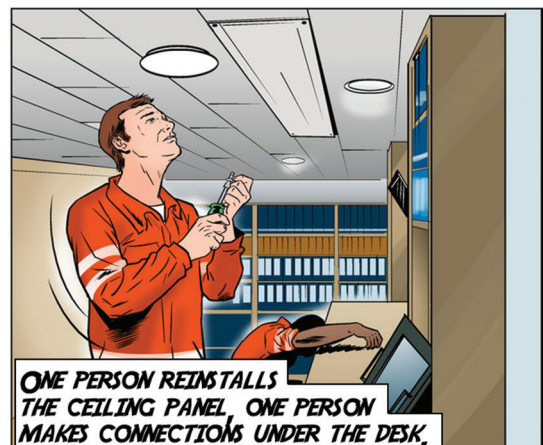
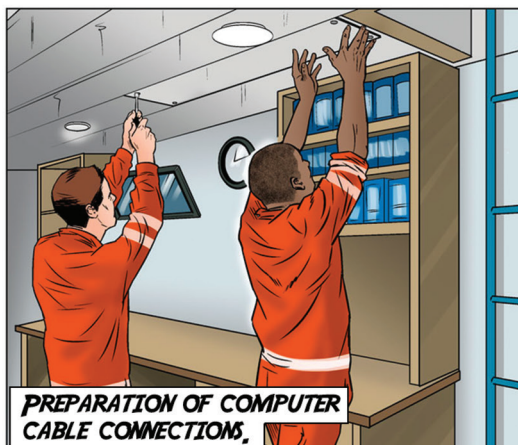
STAY ALERT – EVEN ROUTINE TASKS HAVE RISKS

Seamen often say the vessel is their second home, and therefore, owning the place, they often think on how to improve their daily life on board.

Willingness for improvement could lead to an injury if there is a breach in the safety barriers set by the company.

In this safety post, we illustrate an accident that occurred while slight modifications were made on board.

STAY ALERT – EVEN ROUTINE TASKS HAVE RISKS

DO:

- Stop/postpone the job if assistance is missing.
- Challenge the “routine” perception of the task while preparing it.
- Follow all steps of ship modification procedures.

DON'T:

- Stay in line of fire.
- Bypass steps defined in pre-task planning during work execution.
- Rush to complete a task.
- Roll up sleeves of coverall.
