# RESPECT SAFETY BARRIERS TO AVOID DOMESTIC ACCIDENTS.

### DO:

- Apply LMRA if discovering any products in a container without labeling.
- Store chemicals and other dangerous products in a dedicated and identified place.
- Remove and safely dispose of all stored containers of products without labeling.

### DON'T

- Ever use water bottles to contain chemicals or other dangerous products.
- Forget that containers from the makers are labeled and designed to protect people, the product, and the environment.
- Leave chemicals or other dangerous products around after using them.
