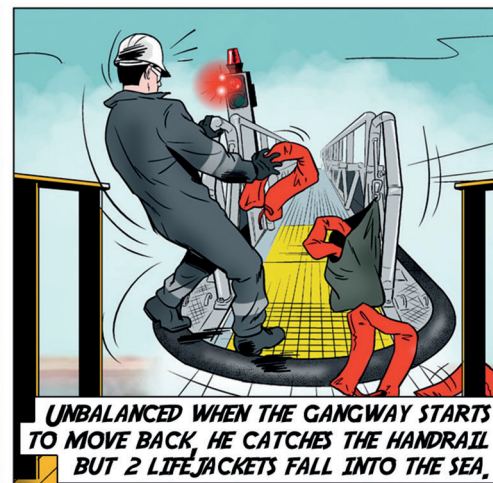
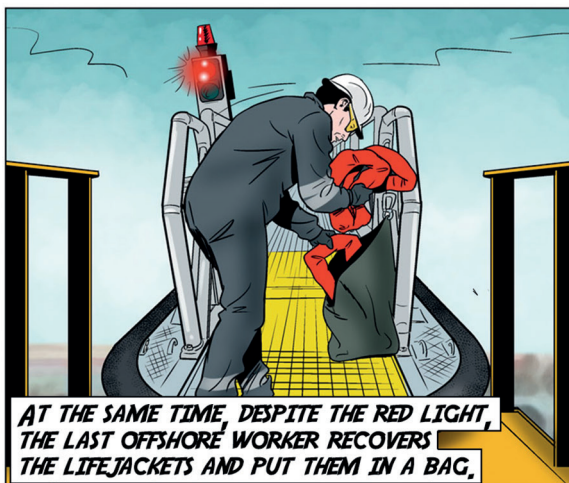
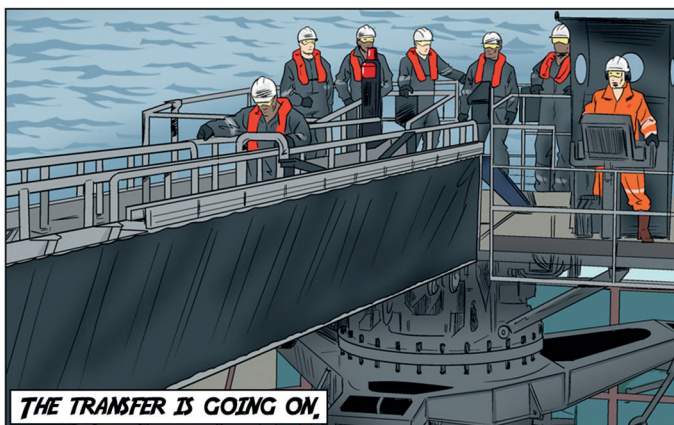
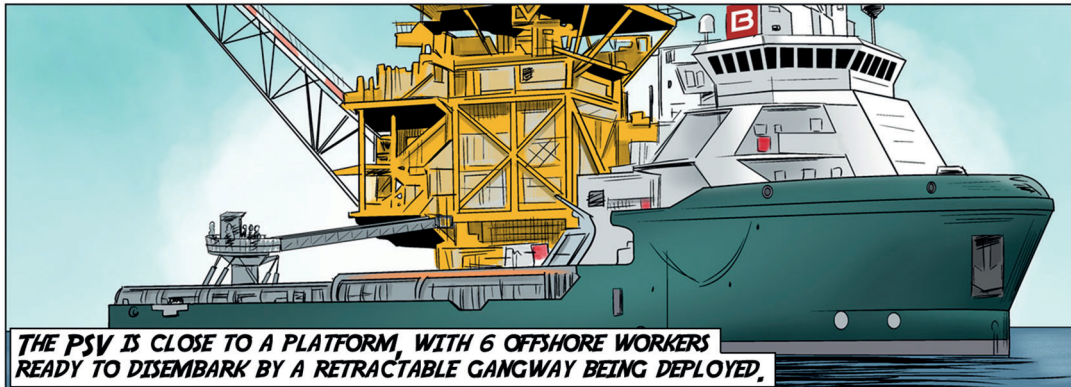


IDENTIFY AND MANAGE CHANGES

Operating method of offshore workers transfer with a retractable gangway set clearly that a gate watch keeper shall be assigned at the platform, to give the green light to the operator for retracting the gangway. Furthermore, if the lifejackets have to be back on board when personnel transfer is completed, an AB of the Vessel shall walk over the gangway, grab all the required amount of lifejackets, and walk back to the vessel. In this NearMiss, there was no gate watch keeper assigned and it was decided to store the lifejackets in a bag installed at the end of the gangway after the transfer. Let's see what can happen when approved operating method is not followed.
