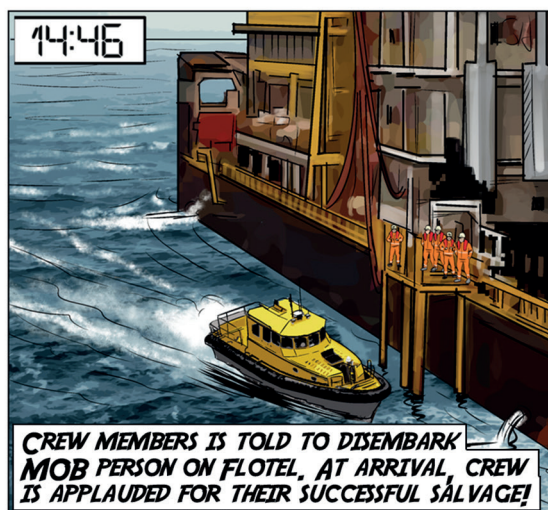
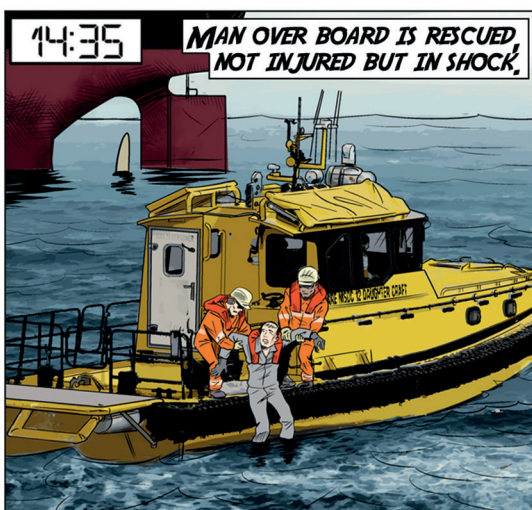
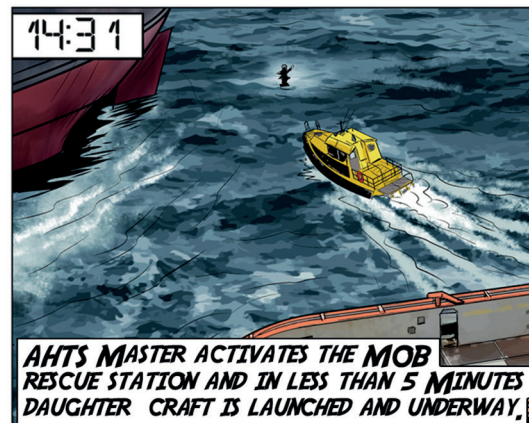
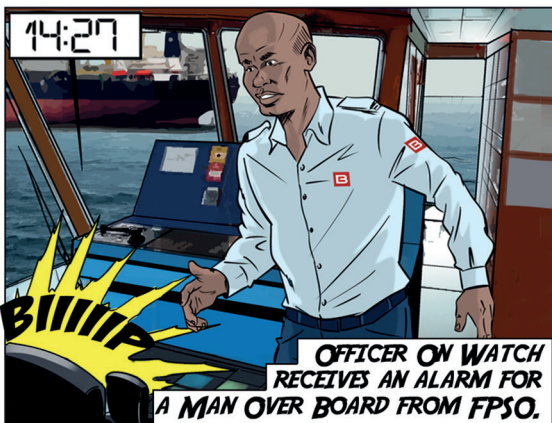
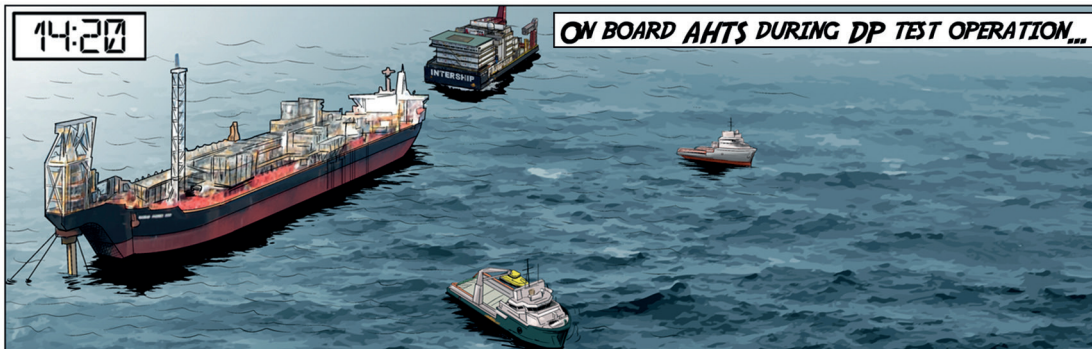


RESCUE OF A MAN OVERBOARD

LIFE SAVING RULES

DO:

- Be prepared for the unexpected
- Regular MOB drill & training
- Develop experience and competence.

DON'T:

- Precipitate without assessment of the situation (weather, sea state, vessel rolling).
- Reduce sound of VHF and miss emergency call.
- Think it would never happen.
