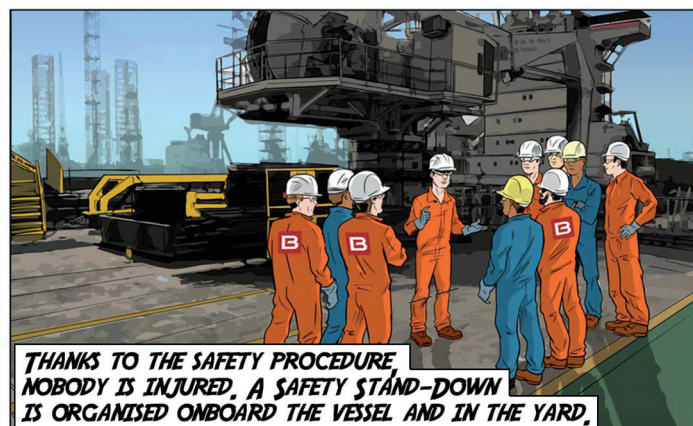
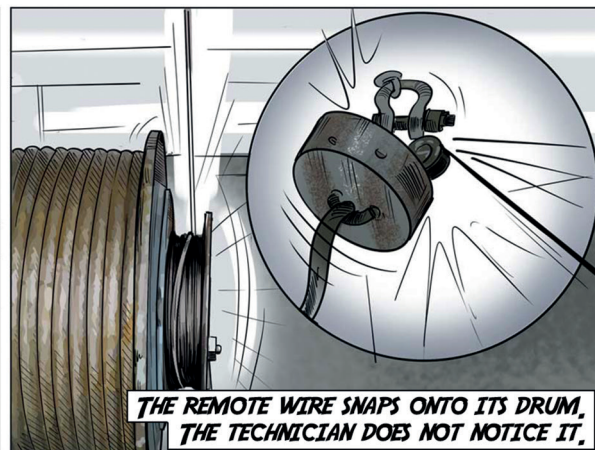
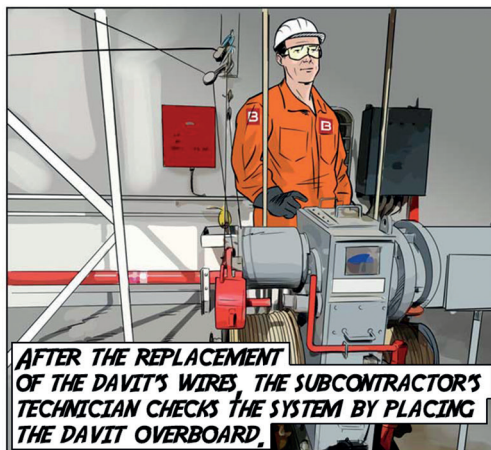
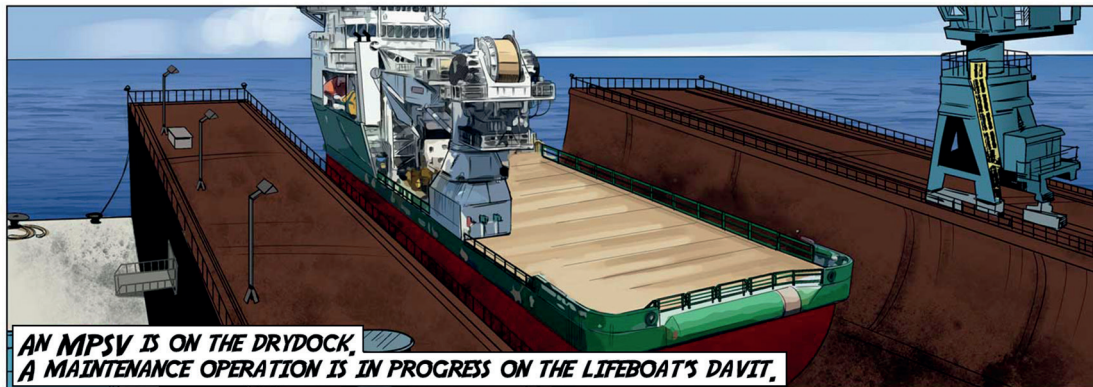




STAY CAREFUL DURING A MAINTENANCE OPERATION

LIFE SAVING RULES

DO:

- Draft a bridging document with the yard covering joint activities on the worksite
- When working at a height, secure the area below
- Check the correct cable's winding before and during the use of a winch
- Review near-misses and safety procedures with all parties

DON'T:

- Carry out any job without having a risk assessment involving all stakeholders, including subcontractors and third party contractor when necessary
- Forget dropped object risk prevention when dealing with suspended equipment
