



LIFE SAVING RULES

DO:

- Regularly check door opening devices.
- Check that alarm systems are operational.
- Remain vigilant at all times in order to react rapidly in case of an incident.
- Report Near-misses to prevent the same type of incident from re-occurring.

DON'T:

- Carry out incomplete checks.
- Count only on the other departments of the vessel to test safety devices.
- Accept complacency in safety matters.
