

BE CAREFUL WITH PRESSURIZED EQUIPMENTS



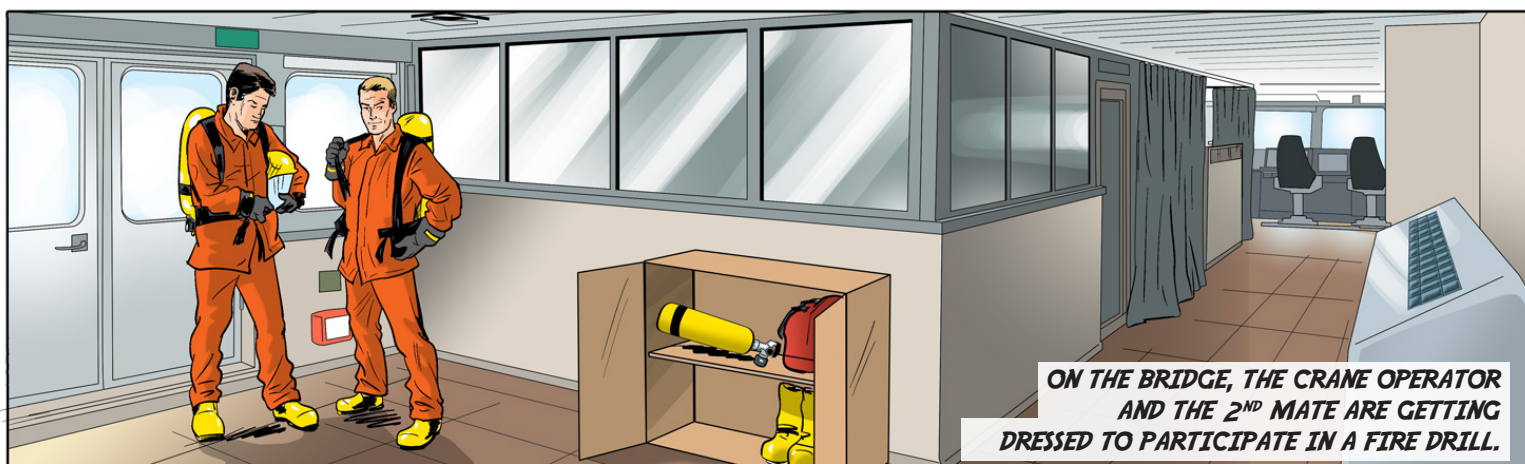

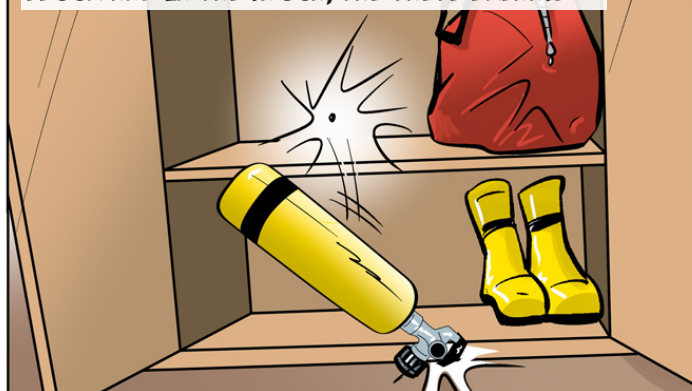
Take action to secure loose objects and report potential dropped objects.



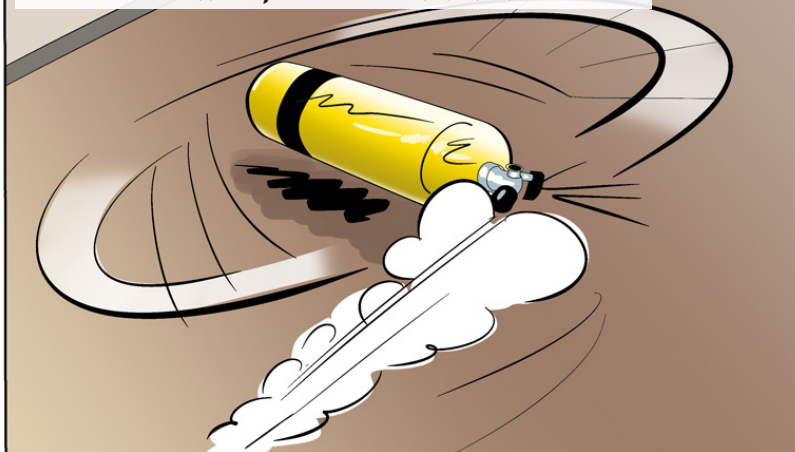
Position yourself to avoid moving objects, vehicles, risks related to pressurized equipments, dropped objects, lines under tension.



PLACED HIGH UP AND NOT PROPERLY SECURED, THE SPARE COMPRESSED AIR CYLINDER FALLS TO THE FLOOR AND IN THE SHOCK, THE VALVE BREAKS.



UNDER THE PRESSURE, THE BOTTLE SPINS VIOLENTLY...



... AND HITS THE CRANE OPERATOR'S FOOT.



DESPITE HIS SAFETY SHOES, THE CRANE OPERATOR IS INJURED AND RECEIVES FIRST AID.
