RISK ASSESSMENT SHALL NOT BE NEGLECTED


Getting the gangway from storage position to ship's side could be considered as a simple lift that may not require a thorough preparation and risk assessment. But when the gangway is placed on a congested deck, when crane operator has limited visibility, when personnel is not familiar with lifting operation, this can lead to accident. In this case the net got trapped in a ROV winch frame and when the AB tried to release it, his hand got pinched between the aluminum frame and the winch structure.

LIFE SAVING RULES

DO:

- Take time for pre task planning. (#1)
- · Organize lifting operations with care.
- Stop the job, when you deem it is necessary to do so. (#2)

DON'T:

- Perform any operation without proper PPE (in this case mechanical gloves rather than impact rigger gloves). (#4)
 • Put your hand in any line of fire and on any load. (#5)
- Perform any operation if line of supervision is not clarified. (#6)
